

TOP 25 CUSTOMER USES FOR FRESH CAB®

INDOORS

1 - Under sinks

Rodents like to travel along pipes & lick the moisture to stay hydrated.

2 - Behind appliances

Including your fridge, stove, washer & dryer, etc.

3 - Closets

Where you love to keep clothes is also where rodents love to nest.

4 - Pantries

These are great food sources for critters.

5 - By pet food

Dog food is the #1 attractant to hungry rodents. Place 1 pouch near storage container.

6 - Crawl spaces

These make perfect hiding places & breeding grounds.

7 - Attics

For far corners, tie string or fishing line to pouches and toss 'em for easy retrieval.

8 - Dryer vents

Rodents crawl in here for warmth. Be sure to cover vents with wire mesh!

9 - Basements

Rodents like places where they can "live" undisturbed.

10 - Garages

Rodents typically run along walls & behind cabinets. Place pouches there.

11 - Cabins, cottages & storage units

Place 1 pouch every 8 feet of floor space before you vacate.

OUTDOORS

12 - Under decks

Rodents love to hide out in these enclosed spaces.

13 - Pump houses

This includes hot tubs, pools & fountains.

14 - Patio furniture

Keep rodents from chewing outdoor furniture by tying a pouch to the underside.

15 - Garden/tool sheds

Use 4 pouches to keep them from eating your seeds & making themselves at home.

16 - Pool houses

These can make great homes for rodent families, especially when they sit unused.

INSIDE VEHICLES

17 - Boats, jet skis & snowmobiles

Place pouches under the cover, paying special attention to engine & battery area.

18 - Trailers

Trailers for livestock, hunting, construction, etc. make great hiding places for rodents.

19 - Motorcycles

Use pouches in engine components & by wiring (remove before operating).

20 - Airplanes

Place inside to protect seats & wiring.

21 - Campers

Up to a 30-foot RV: use 3 pouches throughout interior; also place a pouch in storage compartments underneath your camper.

22 - Cars

Use 1 pouch in trunk, 1 under seats & 1 under hood. (Remove pouch under hood before driving.)

ON THE FARM

23 - Grain silos

Prevent rodents from sneaking in by hanging pouches by entrance points.

24 - Barns

Keep pouches by animal feed & in tack rooms.

25 - Combines, tractors & trucks

Use 1 pouch in wire harness area, 2 in cab & 1 near engine compartment.
